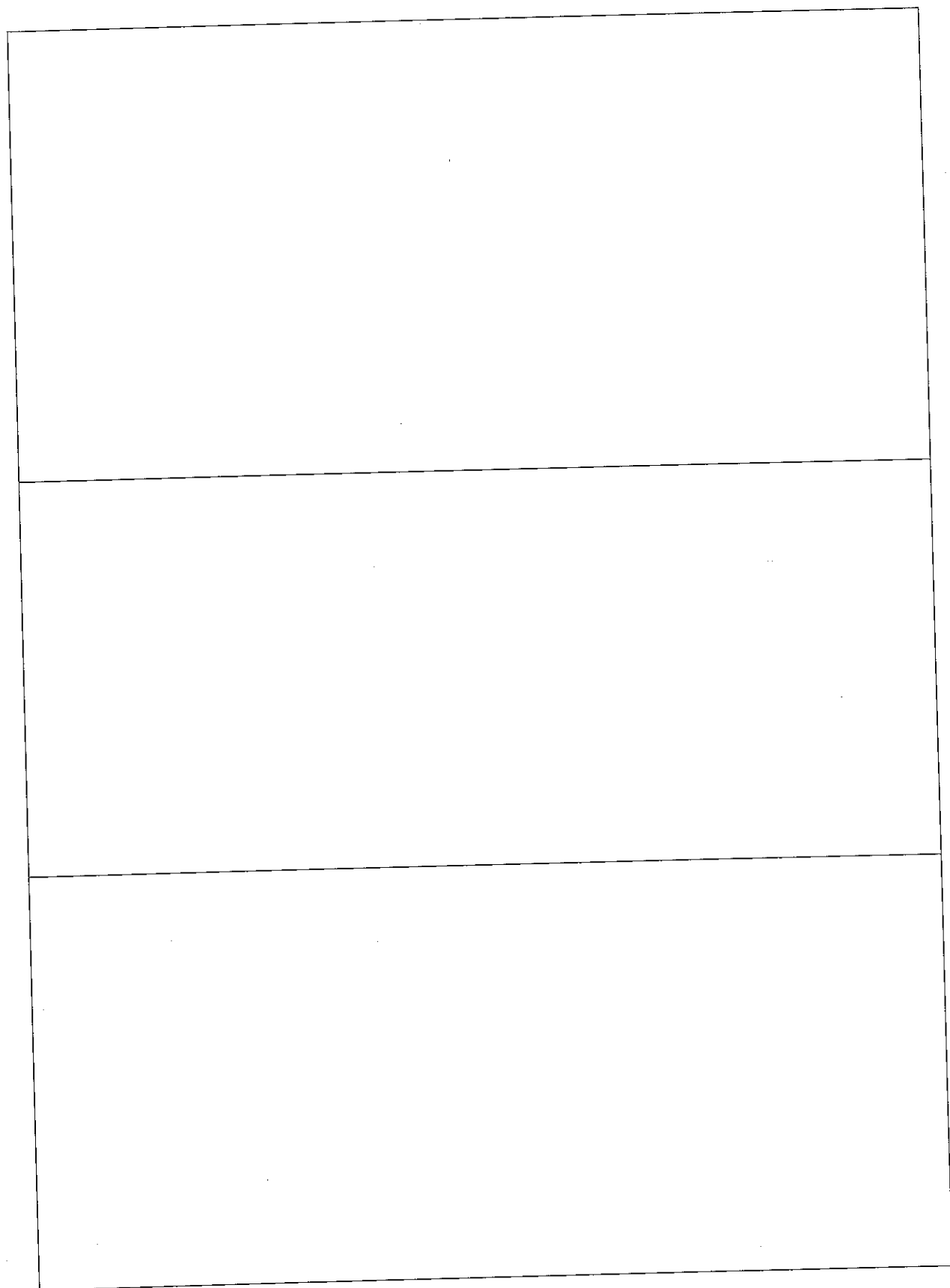
Direction:

1. Each quotation must be grammatically complete. Do not use ellipses.
2. The paraphrase **MUST** be in your own words.
3. The analysis should clarify how the quotation reveals a value or belief of the character **OR** the value of their society.
4. The analysis should be written in complete sentences and be at least as long as the passage quoted.
5. You must use blue or black ink. Do not word process.
6. You must have a total of 20 quotes, 10 for each work.
7. There will be an assessment in the first week of school based upon your summer assignment.
8. You may **NOT** collaborate with other students on this assignment.
9. You may **NOT** use on-line or print resources to assist your analysis **UNLESS** you quote and cite the source.
